

## The crime of disloyalty

British government would be correct to use the country's anti-treason law to charge Islamist preachers who back terrorism. It has been floated in recent years and enjoys widespread popularity in the country, but has met with the obligatory opposition of Party backbenchers and civil lawyers.

The new treason law would seem the response to the challenge of those who are, by any conventional definition, traitors. Treason is the crime of disloyalty, and the so-called "enemies of hate" — such as the ex-Muslim cleric who described 7 London suicide bombers as "alicious four" — are clearly enemies of the British state. Their allegiance is not to the British Crown, or to its laws, but to a hateful, alien, creed that they seek to impose on this means. One of the preachers spoke explicitly: "We don't live with you any more, which is a covenant of security no more."

The Crown Prosecution Service's anti-terrorism unit will meet with senior officers this week to discuss the possibility of pursuing treason charges against three radical preachers. Clearly any will be forthcoming. Instead, it is much more likely the senior leaders in Britain will be charged under other, more numerous, such as those that forbid or solicitation to murder. The message, by raising the idea of treason, British officials at least
