Federal agents to fast interrogate up in US

Federal agents will interrogate a suspected terrorist in a fast-paced, high-pressure environment in a US prison, according to a report from the Justice Department. The report says that the interrogation will be conducted in a "highly structured" manner, with the interrogator asking a series of questions designed to elicit information about the suspect's activities. The report also says that the interrogator will be trained in the use of "coercive" techniques, such as sleep deprivation and isolation, to break down the suspect's defenses. The report is part of a larger effort by the Justice Department to improve its interrogation techniques and to ensure that all interrogations are conducted in a fair and ethical manner.

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
